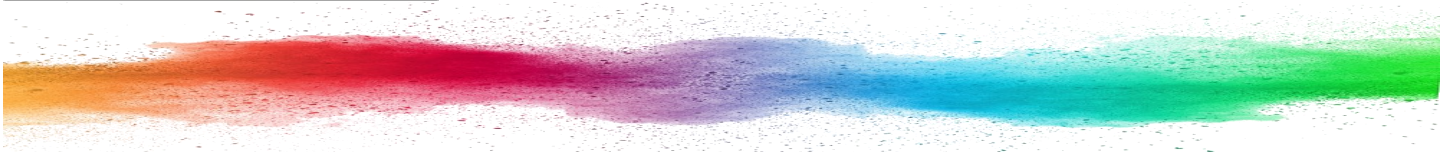

Christmas Party:

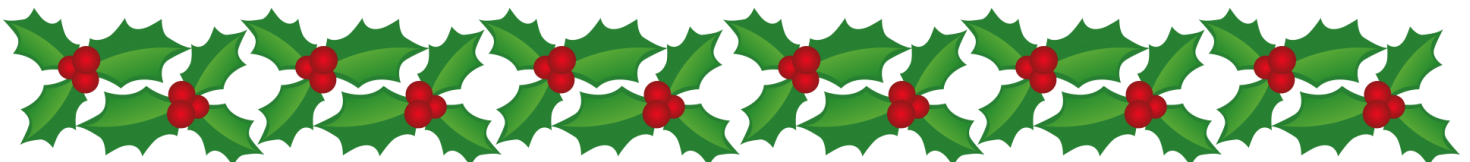
Catherine Schinhofen & LaVerne Stein

I hope you all have been setting aside pieces to enter in the 2023 San Bernardino County Fair this year. Please accept my apologies for this coming to you with such a short timeline. We just received this information after last month's publication of the newsletter. Your submissions need to be registered **no later than April 16, 2023**. The nice thing is that you could even register new or unfinished pieces since we do not receive entries until **April 30th and May 1st**. I will again offer to accept entries from our members who live out of the San Bernardino County area. Just let me know if you would like to participate and I will provide you with my address for you to use when entering. Also, if you need help in getting your item(s) to the fair on the dates listed above, please contact me. I will be happy to pick them up at a prearranged place and deliver them to the fair. The same goes for picking them up and returning them to you when the time comes.

The cost to enter is **\$2.00 per item**. What a deal! Note: All submissions must be completed online. Remember, you will compete with fellow painters at the same skill level as you. There are four levels - Novice (1-3 years experience), Intermediate (4-9 years experience), Advanced (10+ years experience), and Professional (a person who paints as a livelihood i.e. teachers). **I hope that each of you will consider entering at least one piece this year.** This is a way for us to show our craft to the public and, hopefully, gain some new painters along the way!

Tole Art / Decorative Painting Guidelines

- All General Information, Local and State Rules apply to the entire Tole Art/Decorative Painting Department.
- No Entry Limits.
- Each article entered must be the entire workmanship of the entrant and have been finished since June 2019.
- All entries must have a finish on all sides, except fabric.
- Definitions: for the purpose of choosing the right class for entry, please use the following definitions as a guide.

Novice - beginners, students or hobbyists who have painted 1-to 3 years.

Intermediate - students or hobbyists who have painted 4 to 9 years.

Advanced - students or hobbyists who are knowledgeable in the Art and have painted for 10 plus years.

Professional - A person who engages in an event or activity as a livelihood rather than a hobby.

Folk Art - Painting done on any surface in a non-realistic style

Rosemaling/Stroke work - Painting done on any surface using basic brush strokes in various combinations to complete the design.

Realistic - painting done on any surface in realistic style.

Fabric - painting done on any fabric with acrylic or fabric dye.

Education / Tips

Document Covers—you know those awesome clear covers for our patterns that we use for classes and occasionally provided by teachers for classes.

Reuse—once class is over, pull your pattern and vellum or transfer paper out, staple together and file. File as you do other patterns, either by designer or season etc. You know the ones you just have to keep and we have so many.

Reuse document covers for.....

- Upcoming class to keep your pattern clean.
- Your transfer paper from getting wrinkled.
- Place your desired stencils you'll need for class for easy access.
- Painters tape (blue tape), keep a couple of strips on the document protector, it can easily be pulled off and replaced as needed.
- If you're uncertain about a color on your piece, lay the document cover over your piece (empty of papers inside) so you can view your piece. Apply paint on the document protector as if your painting your piece, it will give you an idea if you'd prefer to use another color or even stencil. It saves so much time from having to either sand off and repaint.

Bottom line—these document covers are your best friend!

Here are the details:

- Submissions are due by April 8, 2023
- To submit: Email a high-resolution image (jpeg format) and project description information sheet (see next page) for each submission to ceceliapaints@aol.com with **AGA Teacher Submission** in the subject line of the email. We recommend your project photo be taken with proper lighting, contrasting background and full-frame (as close-up as possible with minimal background showing). Up to 3 photos per project may be submitted to show all project sides.
- If you are unable to submit your project by email, please mail a 4" x 6" quality photo and project description information sheet (see next page) to:

- **Project selection:** Projects are voted on by the Brush Whacker members and the projects that receive the most votes are offered at the Get-Away.
- **Project fee:** For all classes that are selected, teachers are required to provide students with prepped surfaces, patterns, instructions, photos, class paint and any materials needed to complete the project (i.e., glue, DecoPage, screws, hanging wire, material for bows, etc.). Teachers should include the cost of these items in their project fee. Project fees are paid directly to teachers by their students at the Get-Away.
- **Specialty items:** Teachers should list any specialty items students need to bring to class on the project description information sheet. Teachers may sell specialty items (stencils, stamps, brushes, etc.) to their students at the Get-Away. Teachers will be provided with the email addresses of their students so they may contact the students and take pre-orders of specialty items prior to the get-away if they wish.
- **Class size:** Maximum number of students per class is 15. If you have a minimum of 8 students enrolled in your class at the registration deadline, you are under contract to teach that class. If there are less than 8 students enrolled, it will be your choice whether to teach the class or not.
- **Class fee:** Teachers will receive \$15.00 per student for a 3-hour class and \$25.00 per student for a 6-hour class. Teachers receive class fees for all registered students including any "no shows".
- **Classroom:** Teachers will need to bring any equipment they wish to use to teach (i.e., camera, projector, screen, extension cords, power strips, etc.). Tables will be provided by the resort. All classes will be held in a large ballroom. Students will be seated two to a table. A staging area will be available to store your class materials. Please label your boxes clearly.
- **Registration:** We would love for our teachers to participate in the entire event, including classes, lodging, and meals. The painting room fees are covered by meeting our hotel and food guarantees.
- Please email me with any questions about individual meal or room costs.
- A mileage reimbursement is not provided.
- Teachers may submit projects for up to 15 hours of class time...3-hour & 6-hour blocks.

Submissions are voted on by the San Diego Brush Whacker membership, using your photo and description alone, so please be detailed about size, surface, medium and include a high-resolution image or quality photograph for each submission. Voting will take place online from April 15 – 23, 2023. You will be notified of the results by April 25, 2023.
