ANTIQUING



For no-fear antiquing, spray the painting with matte acrylic sealer, dry thoroughly, spread gel medium on the areas to be antiqued, apply antiquing color atop the gel, and blend with a large mop brush. The sealer allows you to totally remove or change your antiquing without harming the painting, the mop brush allows you to place the antiquing medium more accurately, and the gel keeps the paint open for removing or altering the antiquing medium.
