Standing Rules of Desert Quail Painters

Revised November 2022

1. The financial records and the budget shall be kept on a calendar year basis from January 1 to December 31.

2. The dues for each member shall be determined annually ~~by the Board~~ ~~for 2023, the dues shall be \$10.00 per member for the year.~~ Dues are payable before December 1 each year for the following calendar year.

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3. Non-member guests may visit this Club no more than two (2) meetings per calendar year.

4. Board meetings of the Club shall be held at least four (4) times a year. All members are welcome to attend. Regular Club meetings are normally held on the fourth (4th) Tuesday of each month. The November meeting will be held earlier to avoid Thanksgiving week and the December meeting is scheduled to host a Christmas Party and may necessitate a different meeting date.

5. The Club will pay a teacher fee ~~as determined by the Program Chairs in conjunction with the Board on a case-by-case basis to ensure high quality classes at a reasonable fee, according to three possible scenarios: a) standard teacher fee for a class is \$150.00; or b) non-standard teacher fee for a class \$150 and student will receive a \$5.00 discount on class fee if they are required to purchase the teacher's pattern; or c) a teacher/designer that will be teaching their own design will receive \$150 for the first 20 students and an additional \$5.00 for each student over 20 to a maximum of 60 students.~~

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The Club may also pay the current IRS business mileage rate per mile for a gasoline allowance from the teacher's home to the meeting location (one-way) for teachers traveling to teach not to exceed \$50.

6. Programs fees ~~will be determined by the Program Chair in conjunction with the Board and based on the costs to the Club for the specific teacher and class. Non-members will be required to pay a higher fee than Club members.~~ ~~for 2023 shall be \$12 per class for members; \$17 per class for non-members, unless prior Board approval has been obtained.~~

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7. One or more seminars are generally scheduled during the year. These seminars are open to non-members only after Club members have been accommodated. Non-members will be required to pay a higher fee than Club members.

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8. The teaching fee paid by the Club for seminars is negotiated between the teacher and the Seminar Chairperson. The seminar fee charged to the members and non-members will be determined based on the costs to the Club for the teacher, meeting room, supplies, etc. Surface fees may be priced separately.
9. Election of officers for the upcoming year shall be held each year in November with installation of the new officers being at the December meeting.
10. If a member has a request, suggestion or complaint needing attention or any action by the Board of Directors, the following procedure is suggested.
 - o Contact the President or another Board member regarding the nature of the concern.
 - o The President may invite the member to the next Board meeting or may call a special Board meeting if deemed necessary.
 - o Other members, committees, etc., involved may also be invited to present views regarding the concern to the Board.
 - o The Board shall take action on the concern to solve it in a fair and equitable manner.
11. Selling of merchandise at the regular monthly meetings is limited to the sale of painting related items by the current teacher and/or Club members.
12. The Club collects monetary donations or holds special opportunity drawings for one or more charities each year. All selected charities must be official non-profit organizations. It is mandatory for all charitable funds to be reflected in detail on the Club Treasury records.
13. If this Club holds any event(s) which guests of the general public are invited to observe or participate in for a fee, the income from the general public, less a proportional share of the expenses which will not benefit members, will be given to an organization which is exempt from income tax under R&TC Section 23701 (d) or IRC Section 501(c)(3) on an annual basis.
14. These Standing Rules may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members present at a meeting at which a quorum (not less than ¼ of the membership) is present.

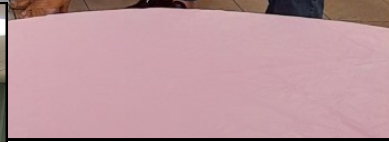

EDUCATION / TIPS

Here are few helpful tips to help when you question something—anything. We’ve all bend there, we think and try to remember where did I read this or who recommended a product or steps in painting.

1. Mix metallic silver acrylic paint with pearlized white paint (1:2). This way, it looks much more like real metal, especially when the light reflects at certain angles. (I thought this is perfect for those mason jar pieces we’ve been painting—for the lids!!)
2. Use a soft brush to varnish. Bristles that are too stiff will leave rake marks in the varnish that even good self-leveling varnishes may not be able to fill. (Great idea. I like keeping a “special brush” set aside just for varnishing. Also, always best to test your varnish if its been opened and fairly down to the bottom, it can thicken and will only be clumpy and ruin your piece—I know this). A fresh bottle of varnish, good weather and PATIENCE. Give your surface time to dry in between varnishing.
3. To fill the very rough cross-grained areas of wood that show up on the blunt end of wood or on beveled wood edges, paint on wood filler that has been thinned with lots of water so that it soaks into the rough grain. Dry, and repeat several times or as needed. Unthinned filler tends to ride atop the rough wood and flakes off immediately when sanded. The watery filler will soak into every pore, making the surface solidly smooth.

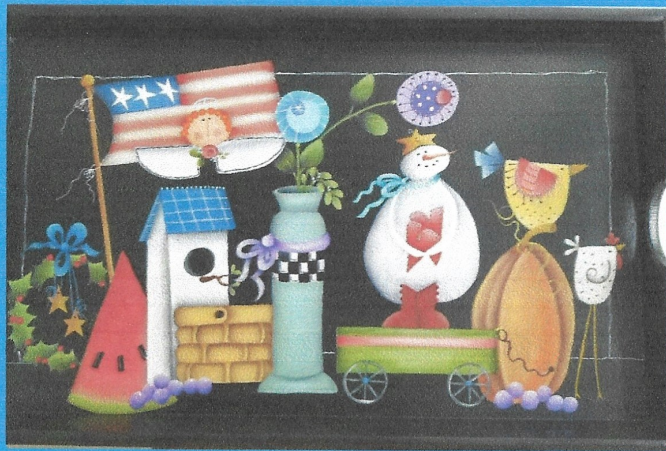

This event is always full of fantastic classes, food, fun, friendship, a great raffle, and lots of laughter!

We would like to invite you to submit projects to teach at the Get-Away. This is an *in-person* event. Classes will be held Wednesday through Friday and are for all levels of painters. Submissions using various painting mediums (acrylics, watercolors, pencils, mixed media, etc.) are welcome.

Here are the details:

- Submissions are due by April 8, 2023
- To submit: Email a high-resolution image (jpeg format) and project description information sheet (see next page) for each submission to ceceliapaints@aol.com with **AGA Teacher Submission** in the subject line of the email. We recommend your project photo be taken with proper lighting, contrasting background and full-frame (as close-up as possible with minimal background showing). Up to 3 photos per project may be submitted to show all project sides.
- If you are unable to submit your project by email, please mail a 4" x 6" quality photo and project description information sheet (see next page) to:

- **Project selection:** Projects are voted on by the Brush Whacker members and the projects that receive the most votes are offered at the Get-Away.
- **Project fee:** For all classes that are selected, teachers are required to provide students with prepped surfaces, patterns, instructions, photos, class paint and any materials needed to complete the project (i.e., glue, DecoPage, screws, hanging wire, material for bows, etc.). Teachers should include the cost of these items in their project fee. Project fees are paid directly to teachers by their students at the Get-Away.
- **Specialty items:** Teachers should list any specialty items students need to bring to class on the project description information sheet. Teachers may sell specialty items (stencils, stamps, brushes, etc.) to their students at the Get-Away. Teachers will be provided with the email addresses of their students so they may contact the students and take pre-orders of specialty items prior to the get-away if they wish.
- **Class size:** Maximum number of students per class is 15. If you have a minimum of 8 students enrolled in your class at the registration deadline, you are under contract to teach that class. If there are less than 8 students enrolled, it will be your choice whether to teach the class or not.
- **Class fee:** Teachers will receive \$15.00 per student for a 3-hour class and \$25.00 per student for a 6-hour class. Teachers receive class fees for all registered students including any "no shows".
- **Classroom:** Teachers will need to bring any equipment they wish to use to teach (i.e., camera, projector, screen, extension cords, power strips, etc.). Tables will be provided by the resort. All classes will be held in a large ballroom. Students will be seated two to a table. A staging area will be available to store your class materials. Please label your boxes clearly.
- **Registration:** We would love for our teachers to participate in the entire event, including classes, lodging, and meals. The painting room fees are covered by meeting our hotel and food guarantees.
- Please email me with any questions about individual meal or room costs.
- A mileage reimbursement is not provided.
- Teachers may submit projects for up to 15 hours of class time...3-hour & 6-hour blocks.

Submissions are voted on by the San Diego Brush Whacker membership, using your photo and description alone, so please be detailed about size, surface, medium and include a high-resolution image or quality photograph for each submission. Voting will take place online from April 15 – 23, 2023. You will be notified of the results by April 25, 2023.

I hope you will consider sharing your talent with us! This event averages 65 painters which includes our members, along with painters from other clubs. Feel free to email Cecelia with any questions or concerns. We are looking forward to hearing from you!
