EDUCATION / TIPS

BRUSHES

- The only brushes you use DRY (without being damp from the water or the thinner) are brushes you drybrush with or mops for blenders. All other brushes should be damp in order to accept and release the paint as intended. Start your painting session by conditioning your brushes in the water or the thinner, and then blot before loading with paint.
- Use your softest brushes for base painting and undercoating. Stiff brushes tend to pick up as much paint as they deposit. Also, always use a large brush as possible for the space.
- After cleaning, shape and place brushes flat on the table to dry. Standing them in a container too soon allows water to gather in the ferrule and damages the brush. When taking a class, place rinsed brushes in a zip-lock bag with brush cleaner until you can clean them at home.

Clean-up Saturday after the customers are gone, I will let you know when you can start packing up.

All vendors are required to be present and on time for clean-up as we must all be out on time.

Rental space– 8ft. oblong and 5ft. round tables (table shape is not guaranteed)

-Tables are assigned when payment is received (location is not guaranteed)

-You are required to attend set-up and clean-up. You aren't required to stay for the duration of the sale. If you are able to help out during the sale please let me know at registration.

-You will be provided a white sheet on your table, your name will be on your table. Decorative cloths, decorations or display materials are up to you. You may use the space under your table for storage.

Member registration begins July 1..... Ends July 8, 2023

Member table fee for 2023 is \$25ea. plus 10% of sales

*The fee paid is for the table space only, any additional racks, trees or displays that aren't confined to your table space must be approved when you register.

Unapproved displays are not allowed and you will be asked to remove them.

-Payment in full must be received by August 1, 2023

-Cancellation- you must notify me by October 1, 2023 for a full refund.

Price Tags

1. All tags must be at least 1-1/2", bigger is better!

2. Print legibly and include the price and your registered name or ID#.

3. Secure them to the item with string or tape carefully away from price/name (no double sided tape please).

4. They can be any color **EXCEPT YELLOW!**

5. One item, one price. If you change a price, use a new tag.

-YELLOW TAGS ARE FOR NON-TAXABLE FOOD ITEMS ONLY! They must meet the same requirements as above.

*These requirements are incredibly important, if we **can't** read the price or name you may not get paid for that item. Make it easy for us to get you paid properly!

We are not responsible for lost or stolen items or missing tags.

Sales

-Your items must be handcrafted.

-All sales must go through our registers , no trading on the sales floor

-There is a hold/ sold area by the registers for things you or customers want to purchase during the sale they must be paid for by the end of the day. Put a sticky note on them with your or the customers name. Do not hold things at/under or around your table!

-For your safety, please don't leave valuables/purses unattended, around or under your table

Additional info

-We advertise and send invitations for this event. You will receive a copy of our flyer so you can make copies and hand them out to your friends and family.

-We have a raffle table with painted items that we sell tickets for if you're interested, the drawing is at Noon on Saturday.

-We provide the tissue and bags, collect and pay the taxes and credit card fees.

-Your sales minus the 10% fee will be paid to you by check in person or by mail and include your tags (if you wish) within 10 days. I'll notify you the date and time!

Again this year I will be sending you boutique information and paperwork via email instead of regular mail to save trees and postage. Please watch your email for communications.

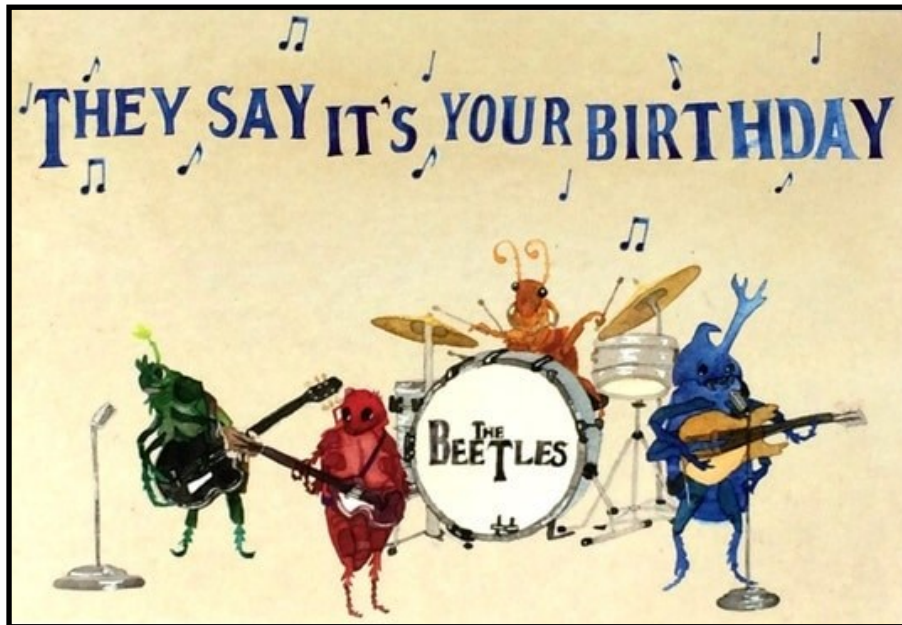
